Food Truck Subcommittee Report:

Stilson discussed having food trucks on township property with the Township Board last night. Bary and Ball said no. Pharo is considering. Atkinson was absent. The subcommittee did not meet. When Cole returns from Florida, we will contact the applicant and let him know where the township stands about having a food truck on township property. Hefferan asked if Atkinson was opposed, would we proceed with any ordinance. Weinzapfel said the question was only about township property. The next subcommittee meeting will determine if we proceed at all.

Master Plan Report:

Maps are in the hands of Mike Woods from NW Council of Governments. He is on vacation. When he returns, he will get them to us, near the end of February.

MTA Conference Reports:

Hefferan said he appreciated the opportunity to go. But the classes he wanted to go to were over

capacity. He was disappointed about that. He got into a lunch meeting about small employer health plan issues. Weinzapfel said it was the first conference they have had at the resort. They had 1300 registered, which was very high. Classes went okay most of the time, but they did have problems regarding room size. He did go to some planning and zoning classes and was proud of what we are doing. He also went to the septic class. He is surprised how far behind some of the communities are. He was able to direct a couple of people who were very interested in our septic ordinance to download it at Milton's website.
