Smoke Alarm Program

In 1960, fire caused the death of 7,645 people in the United States. In 1969, smoke alarms became available to the average citizen. In 2010, there were 3,120 fire deaths in the United States. Along with public education, stricter building codes, and sprinkler systems, smoke alarms have helped save many lives. There are still far too many people dying from fires. The Milton Township Fire Department has established a five year goal for every home in the township to have at least two working smoke alarms / detectors. Smoke alarms save Lives.

If you are interested; Firefighters will come to your home and install or replace 2 basic Smoke alarms or will check and replace smoke alarm batteries in interconnected or hard-wired systems. This program is supported by grants and donations and there is **NO COST** to participants. Smoke Alarms / Detectors should be replaced every ten years.
